



Functional Skills News Update

This update includes information relating to:

- The last registration date for the current Functional Skills English and Maths Levels 1 and 2 Qualifications (legacy qualifications)
- Important changes to the administration and invigilation of Functional Skills effective 1st September 2019
- Qualification approval for the Reformed Functional Skills English and Mathematics Levels 1 and 2

Final registration date for the current Functional Skills English and Maths Levels 1 and 2 qualifications (legacy qualifications)

There are only 12 working days left to register your learners with Skillsfirst on the current Functional Skills English and Maths Levels 1 and 2 qualifications. The **final registration date** is **31 August 2019**.

To ensure learners are registered with Skillsfirst successfully for the current Functional Skills English and Maths Levels 1 and 2 qualifications, please **submit registrations to Skillsfirst by no later than end of business Tuesday 27 August 2019**. Learners who are not registered by the final registration date must be registered on the Reformed Functional Skills qualifications, we are unable to accept late registrations.

Please ensure all centre staff including Assessors, Tutors, Invigilators and admin are aware of these deadlines.

Changes to the administration and invigilation of Functional Skills paper-based and on-screen exams

Following a request from our Regulator, Ofqual, all Functional Skills awarding organisations have agreed to adopt a joint rule for the invigilation of Functional Skills paper-based and on-screen exams, effective from 1st September 2019.

The head of centre must ensure that:

Administration of exams

(‘Administration’ includes initial receipt of confidential materials, secure storage, movement and preparation of materials for scheduled assessments, and registration, secure storage and return of materials to the awarding organisation after scheduled exams are completed).

No tutor of a Functional Skills qualification can be involved in the administration of the assessment materials for level 1 and 2 exams in that subject, regardless of the level they teach.

Invigilation of exams

A centre must ensure that it has a suitable invigilator available for all level 1 and 2 Functional Skills exams.

A Functional Skills subject tutor **must not** be involved in the invigilation of that subject, even if they have not taught those candidates (i.e. a Functional Skills English tutor **must not** invigilate any Functional Skills English exam and a Functional Skills Maths tutor **must not** invigilate any Functional Skills Maths exam, regardless of the level they teach). In addition, no centre staff with a vested interest in the learners result of the assessment(s) should invigilate exams.

Qualification approval for the reformed Functional Skills English and Mathematics Levels 1 and 2

Centres wishing to offer the Reformed Functional Skills qualifications in English and mathematics Levels 1 and 2 will need to submit a Qualification Approval Application Form, together with the attached declaration form in QMIS in preparation for first teaching on 1 September 2019.

If your centre is approved to offer the current Functional Skills English and Maths Levels 1 and 2 qualifications, are not subject to any sanctions, centre policies are up to date in QMIS, together with centre staff CVs, CPD and copy certificates, it will not be necessary for Skillsfirst to carry out an approval visit.

Please note, centres will not be granted direct claim status (DCS) for the reformed Functional Skills qualifications. An external verification visit must be carried out for Functional Skills English which must include an observation of the Speaking, Listening and Communicating (SLC) at Levels 1 and 2 prior to DCS being considered. For Functional Skills maths, Skillsfirst will carry out a quality assurance check prior to DCS being considered.

It is important centre staff have read and understood all qualification handbooks and other supporting documents available on the Skillsfirst website.

In addition, centre staff must be aware of and implement the administration and invigilation requirements for the Reformed Functional Skills qualifications, effective from 1 September 2019, further information can be found on the Skillsfirst website.
